The Opportunity: Building a Future-Ready Network

Live Oak Bank, a Wilmington-based financial institution, prides itself on its robust technology infrastructure. As the bank approached the **end of the usable lifespan** of key network devices, its leadership saw an opportunity—not just to replace aging hardware, but to **strategically assess and enhance their network** for long-term growth.

“We wanted an outside perspective on the health and state of our network,” says **Matt Bosch, Senior Staff Network and Enterprise Observability Engineer at Live Oak Bank**. “We needed to decide on a refresh strategy that aligned with our future needs.”

To achieve this, Live Oak engaged Katalyst for a **Network Analysis Roadmap (NAR)** in Fall 2022, which provided a **comprehensive assessment and a plan** to optimize network performance, security, and scalability.

“They touched on things that we were doing well, things that we could improve, and also provided us a roadmap for the next 12, 18, 24 months,” says Bosch.

A pivotal recommendation from that roadmap was a shift to a **Software Defined Networking (SDN) architecture**, enabling centralized management, better visibility, and simplified operations across their growing environment.

Finding the Right Partner

With a roadmap in hand, Live Oak Bank sought a partner to execute the recommended upgrades. While they conducted a competitive review of other vendors, Katalyst stood out.

“They had already analyzed our environment, which gave them a clear advantage of course,” says Bosch. “But they came back with a better pitch and approach. They had a good perspective and understanding of not just our environment, but what it would take to migrate to a net-new solution.”

Partnering with Katalyst: The Process

Live Oak Bank officially signed with Katalyst for **managed services in July 2023**, launching an ambitious **30-day onboarding sprint**. The urgency of the transition meant the process wasn't without challenges.

"We moved fast—faster than Katalyst typically does for onboarding," Bosch explains. There were some initial bumps "due to our urgency, but in time we ironed out kinks and aligned on processes."

Despite the compressed timeline, Katalyst quickly adapted to Live Oak's needs. The engineers not only ensured **a seamless transition with no major user outages** but also tailored their approach to Live Oak's expectations and unique infrastructure requirements.

"Katalyst has been flexible, even addressing things outside of contract terms," Bosch adds. "Their engineers also take the time to learn and master new technologies when needed."

The Initial Outcome: Immediate Network Stability

- **Significantly improved network stability with minimal disruptions:** "We had a lot of connectivity issues before, but after the refresh and troubleshooting, those have been nearly eliminated," says Bosch. "The stability of our network has dramatically improved."
- **Commitment to resolving a persistent connectivity issue:** "Users were experiencing random disconnections. It took months to diagnose, but Katalyst stayed engaged throughout, ultimately helping resolve it."
- **Enhanced support responsiveness and ongoing network performance monitoring to better enable business demands.** Live Oak Bank now benefits from proactive support and monitoring, ensuring their network remains reliable and scalable, and allowing them to focus more on key business efforts.
